Dr Mohan Babu, Principal, BMSIT \&M, welcomed all the dignitaries and introduced Prof. P P Binu, UGC Nominee and Prof. Shivaprakash, VTU Nominee (first-time attendees) to the other Hon'ble Members of the BOG.

Sri Aviram Sharma, Trustee, BMSET, welcomed all the members and the invitees for the meeting. He extended a special welcome to Prof. P P Binu, UGC Nominee and Prof. Shivaprakash, VTU Nominee.

In his opening remarks Sri Aviram Sharma, Trustee, BMSET, complimented Dr. Mohan Babu G N and all the staff members of BMSIT\&M for the following achievements/developments that have taken place at BMSIT\&M after the last BOG Meeting.

> Students securing Eight Ranks from the University, and prizes at National and State level competitions.
> Job offers to more than 250 Students in the last three months.
> Preparation to start Certificate Programs to provide new-age skills.
The Chairperson then requested Dr Mohan Babu G N, Principal, to take up the agenda.
Dr Mohan Babu G N, the Principal, briefly introduced to the Hon'ble BOG, B S Narayan merit cum means Scholarship being given to students. For the academic year 2020-21, the scholarships are awarded to Ms. Sneha Ramesh and Ms. Kavana H Mahesh by Dr. B S Ragini Narayan, Chairperson, Donor Trustee and Member Secretary, BMSET. The students expressed their gratitude to the Management, their teachers and the institute for the support given to pursue academic excellence. The students also said that the scholarship is a big help to hardworking and deserving students who come from financially weaker backgrounds. The Hon'ble members of the BOG appreciated the sincere comments by the students.

## SECTION-1 FOR CONF©RMATION

41.1.1 Confirmation of the Minutes of the $40^{\text {th }}$ BOG Meeting held on 02.02.2021

The Minutes of the $40^{\text {th }}$ meeting of the Board of Governors held on 02.02.2021 was placed for confirmation. The same was taken as 'Read' and 'Confirmed'.
41.1.2 Action taken note of the discussions/resolution taken in the $40^{\text {th }}$ BOG meeting held on 02.02.2021.

The action taken report on the points were noted and appreciated. The Hon'ble BOG approved to reduce the intake of Electronics and Communication engineering (B.E) from 180 to 120 with effect from the AY 2022-23 and request the AICTE and VTU to allow enhancement of intake in Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning (B.E.) from 60 to 120 from the same AY.

### 41.3.1 $\quad$ I) ACADEMIC MATTERS

b) BMSIT\&M's Rank Under NIRF (National Institutional Ranking Framework

Dr N.C. Shivaprakash congratulated BMSIT\&M on the NIRF Ranking and suggested that BMSIT\&M can aim for a rank below 150 in the future. Sri. Aviram Sharma, Trustee, BMSET suggested that the institute may review its strength and weaknesses with regard to NIRF ranking before the next BOG meeting. Dr Mohan Babu G N, the Principal, informed the Hon'ble BOG members that the NIRF Team at BMSIT\&M has been analyzing and comparing NIRF data of BMSIT\&M with that of other institutions for the past four years to assess the areas for improvement.

Dr Saidapur informed the Hon'ble BOG members about the shortcomings of the NIRF Ranking mechanism. He also stressed that there are areas that are beyond the scope of improvement, such as the appointment of foreign faculties, admission of foreign students and Impact Factor etc. Therefore, BMSIT\&M may concentrate on areas which are within its scope for improvement.

Dr Unnat P Pandit informed the Hon'ble BOG Members that JNU has been ranked very highly in NIRF because of its research and development activity, variety of courses offered, course content, recruitment of foreign faculty and honorary faculty. He further added that the Government introduced NIRF Ranking to bring about healthy competition among Technical Institutes. He informed that NEP 2020 would reset the NIRF Ranking process and parameters to a higher level. He also suggested introducing multidisciplinary courses along with regular courses being offered., for instance, AI\&ML (Major Course) and Economics (Minor Course).

Dr Unnat P Pandit suggested that new programs such as MBA and MS may be explored. He informed the Hon'ble BOG Members that B.Tech students have a keen liking for Entrepreneurship management, and BMSIT\&M can make an effort to introduce such programs.

The Principal explained to the members that BMSIT\&M had earlier contemplated starting MBA Program but had to put it on hold due to AICTE guidelines.

Dr Unnat P Pandit indicated that BMSIT\&M could hire professionals from the industry as honorary faculty to bridge the SFR. Principal informed that BMSIT\&M has already been using Adjunct faculty members for handling full/partial courses and bring in industry perspective to students. Dr Unnat P Pandit suggested introducing evening courses like Diploma in Entrepreneurship for people aged Forty. He also offered to share the content and courses offered at JNU.

## SECTION-5 SUBJECTS FOR DISCUSSION AND APPROVAL

### 41.5.1 Approval of the Boards/Committees under Autonomous BMSIT\&M.

Principal presented to the Hon'ble BOG, the Boards/Committees constituted at BMSIT\&M namely, BOG, Academic Council, Finance committee, Staff council, Board of appointment, IQAC, and BOS of various departments. He sought the approval for these boards/committees so that academic autonomy granted to BMSIT\&M could be exercised effectively.

The subject matter was approved by the BOG.
Dr. Saidapur suggested that given the implementation of NEP-2020, the Institute must have interdisciplinary, transdisciplinary and multidisciplinary approaches, and it's a good practice to have people from different streams of education and
make a common board as it will set the trend for the future and help in developing the content. Principal accepted the suggestion for necessary action.

### 41.5.2 Proposal to Launch Certificate Programs in New Age skills.

The proposal to launch Five certificate programs at BMSIT\&M in AY 2021-22 was presented by the principal before the Hon’ble BOG for advice. Dr Unnat P Pandit and Dr. Kiran opined that such skill oriented, employability enhancing programs are the need of the hour and should be offered by autonomous institutes. However, they suggested that along with these IT-centric certificate programs, programs in Economics and Law may also be explored. It was decided that Principal can discuss the matter with Sri. Aviram Sharma and Director (Admin) and take appropriate action later.

Dr Unnat P Pandit suggested that there should be an Executive Council at the Trust level to foresee NEP-2020 implementation across all the institutions under the BMS Education Trust. He expressed that with such an Executive Council, both the Academic Councir and the IQAC of institutes will get quality inputs, and appropriate decisions can be taken.

For the implementation of NEP-2020, Dr Kiran D M suggested that BMS Institutions can consult with the Centre for Educational and Social Studies (CESS), operating under the leadership of Dr M K Sridhar, who served as a member of the Committee for drafting National Education Policy - 2020. He suggested to start a certificate program on Startup Management which will address the issues that an inventor/entrepreneur encounters while selling his/her product or idea.

Dr Unnat P Pandit suggested exploring M.Tech programs in Defence Technology in collaboration with DRDO. Principal explained to the Hon'ble BOG members that BMSIT\&M tried exploring this prospect, but a very short notice provided by AICTE was not enough for BMSIT\&M to make an application. This may also require a provision of NBA accredited program. A sub-committee can discuss the subject matter and take it up for discussion and approval in the coming months.

### 41.5.3 Policy on the Appointment of Regular and Adjunct Faculty Members.

Principal explained to the Hon'ble BOG Members that AICTE and VTU have issued guidelines (Approval Process Handbook-2021, and Circular No. VTU/PS/202122/2409 dated 06-Sep-2021, respectively) while appointing/promoting faculty members in engineering colleges. Accordingly, an applicant for the professor's position is required to have a post-Ph.D experience of at least five years (as an Associate Professor). Further, the norms say that a post-Ph.D experience of two years is 'desirable' for a candidate to be recruited as Associate Professor.

Keeping in mind the high stature achieved by BMSIT\&M, the need to maintain the high quality of academic ambience, and to scale new heights in the competitive environments (as reflected in NBA, NAAC, NIRF ranking, etc.), it is proposed to upgrade the word 'desirable' mentioned above (with respect to recruiting Associate professor) to 'mandatory'. It would also help to ensure a greater academic maturity among the candidates selected for the respective positions.

All the members of the Hon'ble BOG felt that this upgradation is necessary and resolved that henceforth 5 -years' of post-Ph.D experience should be made mandatory for applicants to the post of a Professor, and 2 -years' of post-Ph.D experience should be made mandatory for applicants to the post of Associate Professor at BMSIT\&M.

The subject matter was approved by the BOG.
Principal also presented a proposal to formalize the process of hiring Adjunct faculty members at BMSIT\&M which was perused and approved by the BOG.

## SECTION-6 ANY OTHER SUBJECT/S WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE CHAIR

### 41.6.1 Controller of Examination (VTU and Autonomous)

The principal brought to the notice of the Hon'ble members of the BOG that expression of interest was invited twice from faculty members to shoulder the responsibility of the Controller of Examinations (VTU and Autonomous) at BMSIT\&M. As there was only one application i.e., by Dr. Hanumantharaju, Professor, Dept. of ECE, Principal suggested that Dr. Hanumantharaju could be assigned with the responsibility of COE (VTU and Autonomous). He also brought to the notice of the members that Prof. Hanumantharaju has been handling VTU exams quite satisfactorily for the last one year.

The Hon'ble BOG Members approved the appointment of Dr Hanumantharaju as the Controller of Examination (VTU and Autonomous).

## SECTION-5 SUBJECTS FOR DISCUSSION / APPROVAL

### 38.5.1 NBA Accreditation to M. Tech in CSE, Civil Engg, MCA and ISE

Principal informed the BOG that the institute has submitted the eSAR to NBA in Feb 2020 seeking accreditation to M.Tech (CS \& E). He indicated that NBA committee is expected to inspect during Oct/Nov 2020 due to Covid-19 pandemic. The BOG appreciated the continuation of accreditation for MCA for one more year (ie., for 2020-21). The BOG approved the proposal for seeking NBA accreditation for B.E in Civil Engg. and approved the proposal to file compliance to NBA norms in the case of B.E. in IS\&E. It approved the timeline suggested by the Principal.

Since no qualified candidates are coming forward for the position of Professor in Civil Engineering, Chairman suggested to explore suitable practicing engineers too.

The BOG agreed to clear up to Rs. 50 lakhs of pending bills of the contactor so that he completes the minor works remaining to get the classrooms and tutorial rooms on the second floor of Laboratory block ready for use before September 2020. The BOG approved in principle the initiation of activities to procure the necessary furniture and fixtures required for the smooth conduction of classes in those rooms. However, the BOG suggested that payout for all these procurements shall be during Octaber 2020.
38.5.3 Providing Laboratory Infrastructure for AI\&ML.Department

The establishment of laboratories for the department of AI\&ML was approved by the BOG in principle. The BOG advised the Principal to initiate activities relating to the establishment of laboratories but plan the payout for procured items during October 2020. Principal informed that the establishment of laboratories would anyway require a minimum of 3 months and payments are generally made after the satisfactory installation of the equipment and software. Hence, payments would be required only after October 2020.

### 38.5.4 AICTE's Conditional Approval - 1:15 Faculty-Student ratio

The requirement of additional 46 faculty members to satisfy the AICTE's new FSR norms for accredited engineering colleges was approved by the BOG. Principal brought to the attention of the BOG that this requirement can be fulfilled in stages over the next two years as permitted by the AICTE. Principal also informed the BOG that apart from the above requirement, the increased strength of students in AY 2020-21 requires hiring 18 faculty members immediately. The BOG after giving its approval, advised the Principal to commence the preparatory activities in this regard so that teachers can report to duty by October, 2020.

### 38.5.5 Creation of Infrastructure for Online Education

The explanation given by the Principal was very well noted by the BOG and the requirement of infrastructure for on-line mode of classes was accepted. Principal was requested to put up proposals for further process. Dr. P. Dayananda Pai, agreeing to the requirement suggested to prioritize the items for capital expenditure and submit it. Sri. Mahagaonkar suggested that, if feasible, some of the persons involved in filming the TV serials may be asked to shoot for recording the classes, as they would be free due to Covid-19 pandemic.

The need explained by the Principal was very well taken by the BOG and the requirement of a comprehensive ERP solution was accepted. Dir (Adm) suggested to explore if the software could be developed in-house. Principal informed that it is high time to procure a professional version of the software as the institution's academic and nonacademic activities have grown enormously and the institute is getting into autonomous system shortly. The BOG agreed to the procurement of software, if its in-house development is not feasible.

## SECTION-6 ANY OTHER SUBJECT/S WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE CHAIR

### 38.6.1 Engagement with National Highway Authority of India (NHAI)

With the permission of the Chair, Principal informed the BOG that BMSIT\&M has been invited by the NHAI to adopt a stretch of National Highway 48 (segment from Dabaspet to Doddaballapur) as a part of their partnership with academic institutes, Principal felt that this engagement would help both students and staff of our institution to familiarize themselves with the actual planning, development, operation and maintenance of highways. It may open up opportunities for the staff and students of our institute to conduct research studies, consultancy, internships and projects relating to highways. NHAl would also benefit in terms of inputs about proper maintenance, research findings and innovations from BMSIT\&M. This proposal does not have any financial obligations on either side. The BOG appreciated the proposal and assured all possible assistance in this regard.

Principal also brought to the attention of the BOG that he and his team had an online interaction with Mr. Sanjeev Kumar Chetti, the Principal Director, Electronics Services and Training Centre (ESTC), Ministry of MSME, GOI in Uttarkhand (interaction was facilitated by Mr. Kishor Jagirdar, Principal Founder, Vision Karnataka Foundation) to explore possible partnership to implement the schemes of ESTC in South India. It was agreed that BMSIT\&M can put out a few of its innovations to the ESTC for validation, and for inviting expression of interest from MSMEs (pan India) for Technology transfer and commercialization based on the mutually agreed terms. Accordingly, as the first step, BMSIT\&M has submitted its technology product 'Semi-autonomous robot for food and drug delivery in Covid19 hospitals' to the ESTC. The BOG appreciated the distinct efforts of the institute to relate academics with society and industry.

Dr. Unnat Pandit who participated on-line from New Delhi, complimented the Principal and his staff for commendable achievements and the transparency in presenting the details of all activities. He expressed that he has not come across
such a detailed and transparent account of activities in any other fora he is a part of. He offered a few suggestions as below:

1. There are many sources of funds available from the Govt of India for the kind of innovation and research activities going on in the institute. We should tap them.
2. We may explore the reasons for anomaly in NIRF ranking by having a thorough review by a third party.
3. We need to make use of the faculty members becoming excess due to the reduction of the duration of the MCA program from three years to two years.
4. We may offer value additional programs, conduct certification and diploma programs in new-age technologies like AI for BE and MCA students. We may use hybrid methods like case study and innovative methods too. Teachers may be provided with online content production tools.

Dr. S B Kivade also congratulated the Principal and his team for the excellent achievements and thanked the management for all the support extended to the institute.

Dr. Kiran D M shared that the way BMSIT\&M has engaged students in online learning during the lockdown period and the care it has taken to prevent the spread of Covid-19 in the campus is highly appreciable. He said that teachers may be trained further to facilitate students' effective learning online, given the uncertainty due to Covid-19. He stressed upon strengthening incubation facility and entrepreneurial development in the institute.

Sri Madan Copal, Chairman concluded the meeting by congratulating the Principal and staff and thanking all the members including Dr. Unnat Pandit, Dr. Kiran DM and Dr. Kivade who participated on-line.

With the permission of the Chair, the following additional agenda points were discussed:

### 35.6.1 Subscriptions to IEEE Journals

Principal explained that the subscriptions to the IEEE journals were facilitated through the VTU consortium so far, but the VTU does not extend this facility now citing the reason that it is very expensive to do so. The subscription is very essential for the research related works and will help all the staff and students. He informed that, it is essential for the Institute to subscribe these e-journals separately and would cost about Rs. 8 to 9 lakhs per annum.

The BOG approved to the proposal of subscribing to the IEEE journals.


### 35.6.2 Policy for Executive Development Programmes:

Principal explained that some of the faculty members are engaged in a commendable job of training executives in companies. This will not only enhance the image of our Institute but also will benefit the faculty and staff concerned. This activity will also add value to the NIRF and other accreditation like NBA, and NAAC. However, there is a need to have a policy wherein our faculty members are encouraged to take up training of the employees of external / private firms and the institute deals with such cases consistently.

The BOG perused the proposal and resolved to adopt a policy to reduce any external expenditure (TA/DA etc., if any) and taxes, commission associated with such EDP from the revenue earned through such programmes to arrive at net revenue. The net revenue may be shared between the institute and the team (Resource persons, staff and administration contributing to such EDP) at the rate of $50 \%$ each. Office staff handling accounts of the EDP may be given $1.5 \%$ from the institute component as is done in BOG approved SRC Policy.

This policy will be valid for one year and can be reviewed thereafter for any change. Principal shall decide on which resource person (faculty) to be permitted and for what duration in a year etc., taking into account the academic load at BMSIT\&M and its adjustments during the non-availability of resource persons).

The Members of the BOG complimented and placed on record the exemplary work carried out by the Chairman and the Principal.

Dayananda Pai, Trustee and Chairman, BOG, BMSCE presided over the meeting and conducted the deliberations vide resolution Ref: ET/324/2018-19 dated 28.03.2019. In the absence of Dr.S.K.Shivakumar, Dr. P. Dayananda Pai will be acting as a Chairman, BoG of BMSIT\&M till alternative arrangements are made.

Dr. Dayananda Pai, Chairman, welcomed all the members of the BOG and the invitees for the meeting.

He further informed the BOG about the health condition of Dr. S.K.Shivakumar and wished for his speedy recovery.

As a matter of recognition, the students who secured VTU ranks for the year 2017-18 were invited and felicitated by the Trustees. The four rank holders were

Out of the four, Mr. Raj Niranjan could not attend and other three were complimented by the BOG and mementos were presented. Parents of Tanuja S. were also present on the occasion. The rank holders thanked the Institute and faculty members for their support in achieving the laurels.

Student representatives from different disciplines were invited for an interaction with the BOG members. While expressing happiness over the academics and other facilities in the college, the students requested for the following.
a) More support for projects and provision of IOT devices.

The Principal informed that support is being extended by the Management for implementation of project and also provision of IOT devices. He said any support required in this regard as endorsed by their faculty members would be provided.
b) A fresh teacher in the Civil Engineering department requires to adopt better teaching. Also sometimes the visiting faculty are not available for clearing doubts if any.
The Principal responded that a teacher with Ph.D has been appointed and he will be given extra training for adopting better teaching methods. He further informed that the visiting faculties have been instructed to make themselves available for clearing the doubts.
c) The placement training can be reduced to one week in $8^{\text {th }}$ semester instead of conducting once in a month.
The Principal informed that the Placement Training is conducted by the outsourced agency of students' choice, four session of 3 hours each in a semester for semesters up to $6^{\text {th }}$. In $6^{\text {th }}$ Semester, the training is given at a stretch of one week before the semester begins.
d) An incubation centre may be set up and awareness on the incubation activities may be brought out among the students. Some of the old computers in MCA department may be replaced.
Principal informed that the suggestion is well taken and an incubation centre is being initiated. Some of the old computers in the MCA department have already been replaced with new ones and this process will be a continuous one. MCA department has significantly more number of computers than prescribed by AICTE.
e) The college fest 'UTSAHA' has to be announced much earlier so that students can prepare and participate in a better way.
The dates for UTSAHA have been indicated in the Calendar of events at the beginning of the semester 2 months in advance, which was displayed on the students' Notice Boards and Website too and the students could come up proactively and prepare for the event. However, a separate notification / circular will be sent in advance for UTSAHA henceforth.
f) Project Labs for Mechanical Engineering is needed.

Principal informed that for Mechanical Engineering, a 300 Sqm space has been provided and students can consult their HODs. He assured better fabrication facility could be provided.
g) More facilities needed for sports (space / ground).

Dr. P. Dayananda Pai, Chairman, explained that the space for outdoor sports is a constraint due to the various construction activities of the STP, Road and the Gate. The ground will be available for outdoor sports once the construction is completed.
h) An ATM inside the campus to be provided.

Principal informed that the Allahabad Bank inside the campus has been requested to provide an ATM.
i) Lab / workshops for projects may be provided.

Principal informed that separate project labs have been provided clustering the digital departments. A new 300 Sq.m workshop has been provisioned exclusively for such projects in Mechanical Engineering. Similarly, dept. of EC, TC and EE have been provided an exclusive project lab.
j) Transport fee (college bus) of Rs.22,000/- a year is too heavy for a final year student who comes to the college once in a week.
Principal responded that $8^{\text {th }}$ semester students are supposed to attend 4 days in a week and not one day. The facility is being extended to the students with 'No Profit No Loss' basis. However, the provision of transport is being made keeping the majority of students in view and usage of the college bus is not mandatory for any student.
k) More support is required for interdisciplinary projects.

Principal informed that more and more interdisciplinary projects are being encouraged by the Institute. Every year on an average the Institute is funding Rs.3-4 lakhs supporting such projects. Specific requirements if any can be forwarded through the department HOD's to the Principal for consideration.

1) Better facility is required for the canteen.

Principal informed that due to the land encroachment by the farmers, the canteen had to be shifted on an ad hoc basis into the space provided for the lab adjacent to the workshop. However, provision will be made to provide a regular canteen.

Chairman thanked all the students for their valuable suggestions and asked the Principal to take proper action in this regard. All the students left the Board Room.

The actuals for the financial year 2018-19 and the budget for the year 2019-20 was presented and the same was approved by the BOG.

### 34.5.2 <br> Enhancement of Salary to Principal

While the subject was taken up for discussion, Principal and Staff of the college recused themselves from the meeting and left the Board Room. The BOG Members discussed in detail all the progress achieved by the college during the tenure of Dr.Mohan Babu as Principal especially the intake and progress achieved in Academics and getting accreditation. All the BOG Members felt it is most appropriate to consider enhancement of salary to be paid to Dr.Mohan Babu. Thereafter BOG unanimously agreed to provide him monthly allowance of Rs. $50,000 /$ - and this amount to be met form the ICD. This amount will be over and above his prevailing monthly salary. This additional allowance of Rs. $50,000 /$ - will be with effect from 1/4/2019. BOG Members asked the Principal Dr. Mohan Babu to join the proceedings. BOG Members complimented Dr. Mohan Babu and conveyed the BOG's decision to providing with an additional monthly allowance.

### 34.5.3 Facilities to Newly Appointed Deans.

The request for an additional vehicle (car) was noted by the BOG and it was agreed that a new car will be purchased for the use of the Principal and the present Principal's car can be used by the Deans for any official movements.
34.5.4 BMSIT\&M Sponsored Research and Consultancy Policy

The SRC policy for BMSIT\&M was placed at Appendix IV and the same was approved. Sri Madan Gopal requested the Director (Admn), BMSET to prepare uniform welfare policy for all Institutes under BMSET.

The BOG agreed that the contribution from the staff may be raised and remitted to the authorities concerned. The BOG has approved to contribute Rs.50,000/- for the same cause by the Management.
34.5.6 Revision of festival advance from Rs.5,000/- to Rs.10,000/-

The BOG approved to enhance the festival advance from Rs.5,000/- to Rs.10,000/as per the Government Order w.e.f. 01.04.2019.

## SECTION-6 ANY OTHER SUBJECT/S WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE CHAIR

### 34.6.1 Restoration of Maternity Leave to 180 days.

The BOG resolved to restore the Maternity Leave facility to 180 days as applicable to the female employees as per the GOK Order No. FD 4 SRS 2012 dated 14.06.2012.

### 34.6.2 Allowances to key functionaries.

The Principal presented the proposal of providing the following allowances to the Key Functionaries.

| Key functionary | Amount (Rs. per month) |

| Vice Principal | Rs.15,000/- |
| Deans | Rs. $10,000 /-$ |
| HODs | Rs.5,000/- |
| Administrative Officer | Rs.10,000/- |
| Registrar | Rs.10,000/- |

The BOG approved the proposal to extend the allowances as above with effect from $1^{\text {st }}$ April 2019 with the following remarks:

- Allowances for Vice Principal, Deans and HODs, as proposed, will be paid directly.
- The enhancement of salary to the Administrative Officer will be effected from BMSET as he is an employee of BMS Educational Trust.
- Registrar will be provided the enhancement by way of sanctioning number of increments so as to cover the increase of Rs.10,000/-.

Before conclusion of the meeting Mr. Gowtama M V, Chairman \& Managing Director, BEL complimented the Management, Principal and his staff for the achievements of the Institute, and also the efforts made by the Principal for starting a new UG programme in Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning, first college under AICTE to start such a programme in India.

Sri. G.S. Mahagaonkar suggested that possibility of starting courses for Indian Railway Services and Aircraft Maintenance may be explored.
