The induction program at the Department of Civil Engineering commenced for the 2019 Batch on 3rd August 2019 from 2:45 pm. As a part of the induction program for the first years, primarily an Institutional presentation showcasing its achievements was highlighted by Dr Rajesh Gopinath (HoD) to the audience compromising of Students and their parents. 9: 00 AM to 9:30 AM: Welcome address & briefing and Thought for the day

INTRODUCTION TO CENTRAL FACILITIES:

During the 2nd day (5th Aug 2019) of induction program the first semester students of the Department of Civil Engineering were given a briefing on the Central facilities and Cells present in our college. The green initiatives taken up at BMSIT&M campus, including the practice of using treated waste water for gardening, Rain water harvesting and the use of the dried sludge from the STP was explained to the students. 9: 00 AM to 9:30 AM: Ice Breaking Session

Session description: Ice breaking session for 1st semester civil students was carried out by Mrs Prasanna Faculty, Dept of Civil Engineering between 9 AM to 9.30 AM on 6th Aug 2019. The class was divided into five groups, each group was given the same set of props with which they had to create something unique.

Session Outcomes: The students actively participated in making various models like row boats, aeroplanes, Wall hangings etc. Overall the session was very interactive.

Session outcomes: The students discussed posters with respect to the observations made and outcome of the project and also they were taken to the Model room where some of the PBL models are exhibited, and explained them thoroughly regarding those projects.

9: 00 AM to 9:30 AM: Ice Breaking Session

Session description: Ice breaking session "Colour strike" was conducted by Dr Sreedhara B M Faculty, Dept of Civil Engineering, to students of 1 st year B.E (Civil). Each student was asked to make use of chalk and draw on the board and this was continued till the last student completed it. Later the student were made to form a group and create a story on the events which was been depicted on the board.

Session Outcomes: The outcome of this event was to encourage creativity and team work and narration skills.





9:30 to 1:00 PM: CREATIVE ART SESSION:

Session Description: The creative art session was conducted by Gurusiddappa G E, Associate Professor, Acharya Institute to first year civil students. Sir has explained the principles of design and design elements using power point presentation. The exercise was conducted on design elements using geometrical shapes. Students created the 2D drawing composition using the basic geometrical shapes of various sizes and the suitable colours are filled in the shapes.

Session Outcomes: The outcome of this events was to get the knowledge about the drawing and geometrical shapes. As a civil students this session was very useful to study the use of these geometrical shapes in building drawing.





2:00 PM to 4:00 PM: Sports Session

Session description: The first year students of Department of Civil Engineering were introduced to the Sports session with an introductory talk by Mr Krishnappa, Inspector, Yelahanka Police Station who spoke about the traffic Rules and Regulations. Students were made aware of the consequences of breaking the Traffic rules. Mr Mallikarjun Patil, Director –Sports, BMSIT&M gave an account of all the Indoor & Outdoor sports facilities available in the campus. Mr Raghavendra, Alumni of Telecommunication Department who was a basketball player himself spoke to the students on "How to balance Sports and Curriculum".
