
Objective:

Frequency of Meeting: Once in a month

Roles and Responsibilities: The Reader's Club of our institution is dedicated to cultivating a love for reading, critical thinking, and creative expression among students. It provides a forum to not only debate books but also to exchange ideas, discuss different perspectives and learn new concepts. The goal is to provide students with as many creative and artistic possibilities as feasible, to encourage students to analyse and interpret texts from multiple perspectives, to promote open discussions and respectful argumentation on social, cultural, and philosophical themes emerging from literature, to host movie screenings followed by critical discussions. There will be club sessions organised each month where the students will choose a book to read and will discuss what they have comprehended in the next club session.

1. Quill Quest - 2nd May 2024


2. Clue Quest - 12th Nov 2024

Clue Quest was a thrilling murder mystery event conducted under the Literary Club. Participants stepped into an interactive investigation where they analyzed clues, questioned suspects, and solved puzzles to uncover the culprit. The event combined suspense, teamwork, and critical thinking in an immersive, story-driven format.



3. Debate (Verbal Vendetta) - 7th June 2024 and 25th April 2025

Debate was an engaging event conducted under the Literary Club where participants spoke either for or against a given motion. Speakers presented arguments and rebuttals within a limited time frame. The event encouraged critical thinking, confidence, and persuasive communication skills.



4. Stand Up Comedy (Shok Sabha) - 7th June 2024 and 25th April 2025

Stand Up was a lively event conducted under the Literary Club where participants performed short stand-up comedy acts. They presented original jokes, humorous stories, or observational comedy within a set time limit. The event encouraged confidence, creativity, and stage presence while entertaining the audience.



5. Movie screening (LitFlix & Chill) – 30th May 2025 and 29th September 2025

A screening of Dead Poets Society and The Social Network was organized for the students as part of the club's literary engagement initiatives. The films were chosen for their connections to themes of literature, authorship, creativity, and intellectual identity. The event witnessed active student participation and insightful post-screening discussions.
