BMSIT NSS Unit organizes mega blood donation camp in association with Lions Club



Bangaluru (TSIT) The NSS Unit of BMS Institute of Technology and Management (BMSIT), Yelahanka, organized a Mega Blood Donation Camp on 21 November 2025 in collaboration with the Lions Club of Bangalore Megacity, Lions International District 317A, and Lions Blood Centre, Vijayanagar and Yelahanka. The camp began with an inaugural ceremony attended by Lions District Governor Lion Dr. G. Mohan, Dean (Student Welfare) Dr. Ambika R, Dean (Academic Affairs) Dr. K.M. Sathish, NSS Programme Officer

Dr. Manoj H.M., and Dr. Babu Naik. Office bearers of the Lions Club, including Lion Ashok Kumar Kulkarni, Lion Dr. M.N. Sathyanarayana, Lion S. Manoj Kumar, Lion K.
