INSTALLATION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

ROTA UTSAV

Rota Utsav was a fundraiser event under club service avenue which was conducted on 23rd October 2019. In a duration of one hour, 36 rotaractors could attract more than 200 students by conducting several entertaining games. Drama Club of BMSIT joined their hands with us to entertain the crowd with their performance. We raised Rs.2590 as funds collected through entry fee and the same amount was used for an event named Pratibha.











TREK TO EDUCATE


Trek to Educate: Our club in association with Rotaract club of Bangalore Golden Rock hosted a trekking event to avani betta under club and community service avenue. Many other colleges like PESIT, Nagarjuna Degree College participated along with us. This was a ticketed event with a fee of Rs.500 per person, which included all breakfast, lunch and transport facilities. RCBMSY had 46 participants. We could collect Rs.23000 which was used for education cause.

WASH IN SCHOOLS PROGRAM

This event was conducted on 7th January 2020 as a Joint Project with Rotary Bangalore Yelahanka under community service avenue. Aim of the program was to teach school kids the proper way of washing hands which is a part of Swachcha Bharath Abhiyan. Along with the posters, liquid handwash and dispenser provided by Rotary Bangalore Yelahanka a team of 8 rotaractors conducted this event in 2 schools which are avalahalli govt. school and singanayakanahalli govt. school consisting of 110 and 180 students respectively. The training session was conducted for an hour which included a demonstration, short speech and the repetition of the procedure by all the students.










CLOTH AND PAPER DONATION DRIVE

The drive consisted of two parts: The Cloth drive and the paper drive. For this a team which consisted more than 16 volunteers worked together to collect rejected clothes and old newspapers and books. Cartons were arranged by one of the volunteers and were installed at various parts of the college campus. The collected clothes are to be distributed at an Orphanage. The old books and newspapers were sold and we earned Rs. 650 which was added to the treasury.

LIME GREEN PROJECTS

To help people deal with issues related to mental health and stress in quarantine, RCBMSY launched the 'Lime Green' Project. The subjects addressed by the project ranged from personal issues like tackling inferiority complex and body positivity to wider ranging issues like tackling familial troubles caused by the lockdown. 
























STEP IN AND UP LIME GREEN INITIATIVE
