
2 DAYS ZUMBA WORKSHOP

BLOOD DONATION DRIVE

A Blood Donation drive was organized by The Rotary Club of Bangalore, Yelahanka in partnership with the Rotaract Club of BMS Yelahanka on 23rd August from 11am to 3pm. The event was graced by the MLA of Yelahanka, S.R Vishwanath who spoke about Blood Donation and also threw light on the importance of blood donation in these troubled times due to the pandemic as there is a dire need of blood more than ever now.

A mutual partnership between Rotaract Club of BMS Yelahanka, Rotaract Club of Yelahanka and Rotaract Club of NDC and Rotary Bangalore Yelahanka (Parent Rotary) was observed at the Blood Donation Camp on 23rd August, 2020. The collaborative project was conducted in three locations, namely, Newtown Club, Purva Venezia and ZED Apartment. Our club's contribution towards the camp was primarily directed towards the camp set up and awareness cycle rally. The camps witnessed a collective donation of 77 blood units. 6 rotaractors participated in the awareness cycle rally from our club to escort the mobile medical van from New Town Club to Purva Venezia while spreading awareness of Blood Donation on our way. The partnership was a commendable platform to connect with the Rotarians and marked our first amalgamation for RIY 2020-2021.



BLOOD DONATION DRIVE

Fundraiser for Sahil's Cochlear Implant Surgery.

This event was a fundraiser to aid the efforts of Rotary Bangalore Yelahanka in paying for the cochlear implant of a young boy by the name of Sahil. We independently hosted a fundraiser during the Blood Donation Camp on the 23rd of August. Handmade cloth masks, tailored by us were sold to the guests and donors by our Rotaractors. Eminent personalities that supported this fundraiser include MLA of Yelahanka, Mr. Vishwanath, ACP Srinivas Sir, Rtn. Dr. Brij Mohan, President Parent Rotary, RBY, Rtr. Likitha P, Pres. Rotaract Club of Yelahanka, Club YSD Rtn. Vanitha Narayan. The cause supporting the fundraiser was to aid the cochlear implant surgery prescribed to Sahil, an 8 year old boy suffering from a progressive hearing loss. The donation was made through Rotary Bangalore Yelahanka Charitable Trust, under Rotary Bangalore Yelahanka and Rotary International, that took up the initiative to financially support Sahil's family by funding his treatment. The fundraising tactic received brilliant recognition with over 35 masks being sold.
