Initiation:

To sensitize our students about investments and savings, a webinar was planned on 4th July 2020. The topic chosen was “Investments for Young People”

Implementation:

Webinar was arranged in association with vaave.com

Session Briefing:

Mr. Aranya started his session by defining the “Finance” and “Savings” term. Later he spoke about need of saving money. He mentioned the prime goals of saving are to (i) beat inflation (ii) lead better life by becoming self-sustained. He then interacted with the audience about Mutual funds. He classified the mutual funds into two categories (i) Maturity period ones and (ii) Investment objective based.

He also explained about open ended fund, closed ended funds, interval funds, equity or growth funds, debt or income funds, balanced funds, liquid or money market funds, Gilt funds etc.

The speaker then explained about the meaning of Systematic Investment planning (SIP). A Systematic Investment Plan is an investment vehicle offered by mutual funds to investors, allowing them to invest small amounts periodically instead of lump sums.

The audience had an engaging session with the speaker. Mr. Aranya cleared many doubts and concerns about risk involved in mutual funds investment

Although a direct survey was not carried, the overall appreciation from the student community was excellent. Even the speaker felt happy about the interaction.

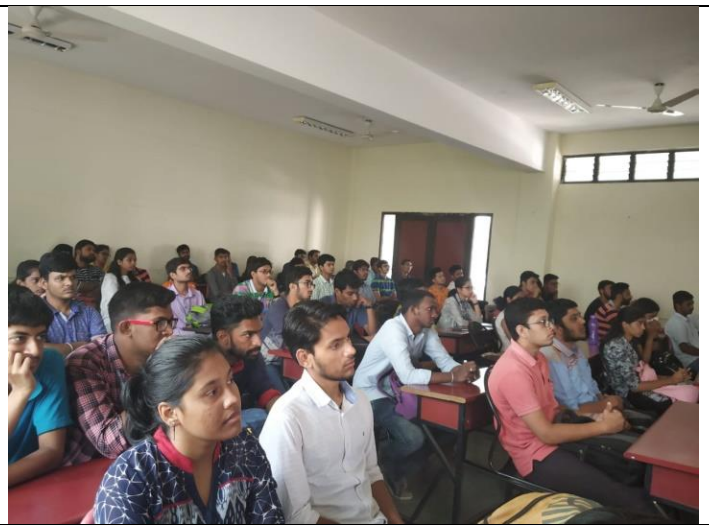
Such talks should be continued in every year to sensitize the students about the power of investments and savings.

Session Briefing:

As preparedness for campus placement, an informative talk on “Campus life, academics, and placement preparation” was organized by the dept. Of EEE on the 11th of April 2020. This session was open to all students of BMSIT. It was attended by closed to 90 participants from various disciplines.

The speaker started the session with self-introduction followed by the experience sharing. She asked the juniors to get in touch with alumni, seniors, and teachers for mentorship. 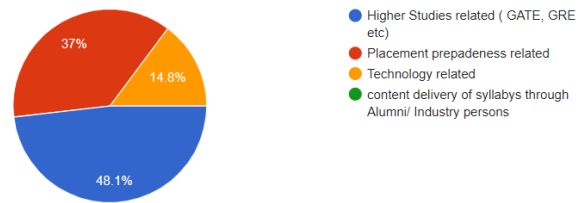
Survey feedback trend:
