- (vii) With regard to the prevention and prohibition of Ragging in BMSIT&M all the heads of departments conducted a briefing for seniors of their respective departments with regards to anti-ragging and briefed them about what constitutes ragging and the action that students indulging and abetting ragging.
- (viii) Faculty travelling in the college buses were entrusted the responsibility to ensure that no ragging takes place in their respective buses.
- (ix) Heads of Departments interacted with the I year students of their respective departments and instructed them to report to their proctors / HoDs any incidence of ragging.
- (x) The security personnel have been deployed within the college campus and the Ladies hostel as a precautionary measure to avoid any untoward incident. They have been instructed to report immediately of any such incident.
- (xi) Students have submitted an anti-ragging affidavit along with their parents.
