- Dr. M. Sridevi, Head, Department of MCA appreciated the relentless efforts by Mr. Shashi

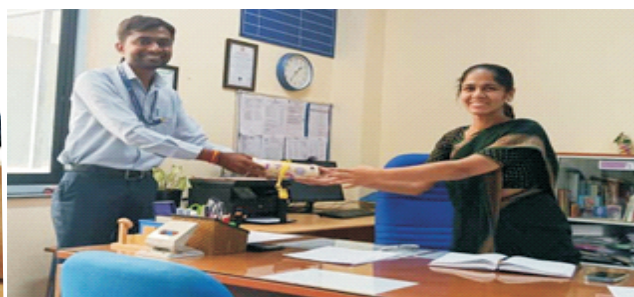

session on Innovation, research, patents and Entrepreneurship was done. Methods of bridging the gap between Institute and Industry were also highlighted during the program.

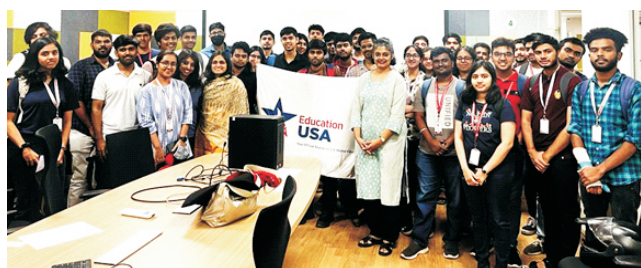

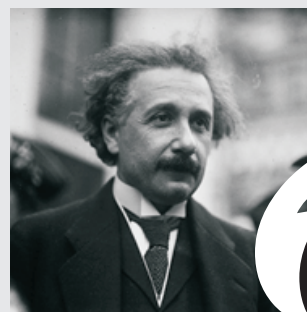

Proctoring system and Counselling Report

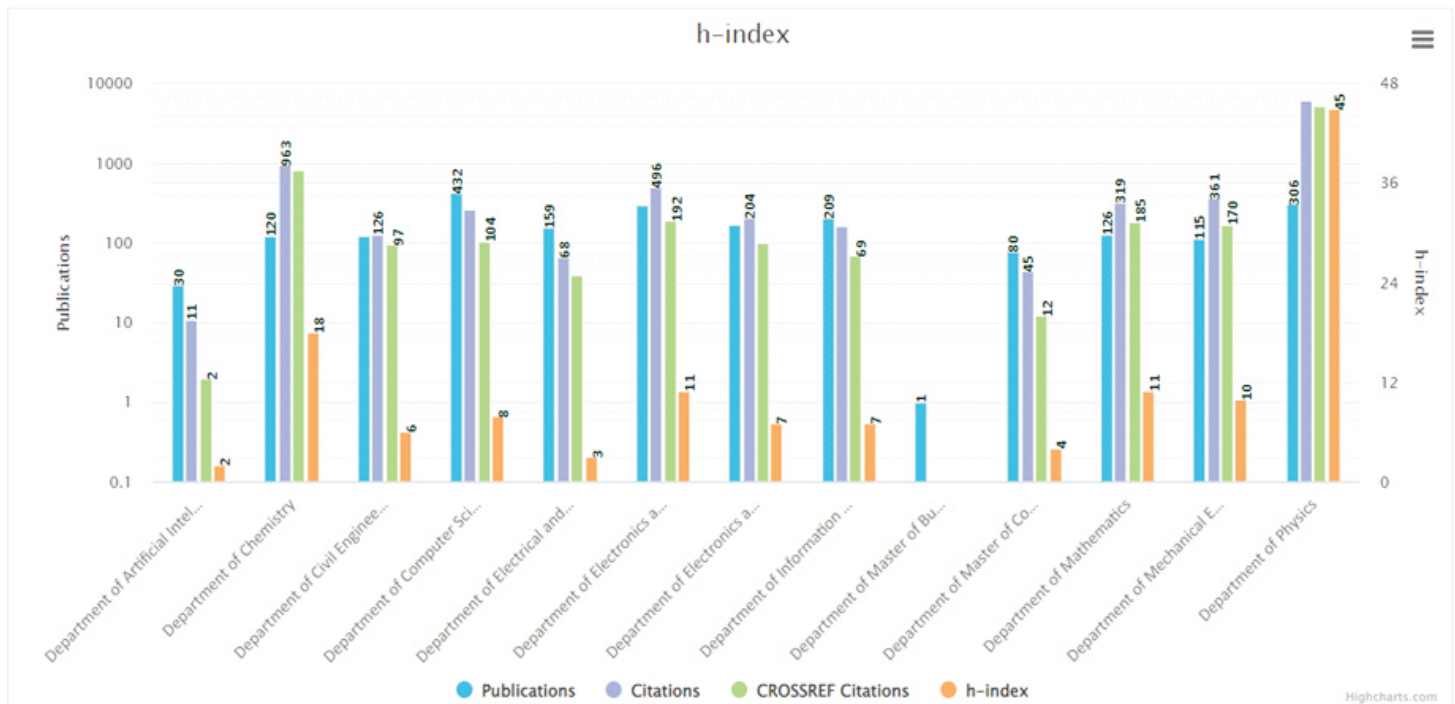
Under each proctor (assigned faculty) a maximum of 25 students are allocated. Proctoring of each Department is monitored by a team of deputy chief proctors and a chief proctor at the institutional level. Students who have behavioral issues, or personal issues can avail the guidance of professional counsellor Mrs. Chetana Srinivas. She visits campus on Tuesday and Friday from 1.30 pm to 4.30 pm. She provides counselling for 'Behavioural', 'Personal', and 'Academic' issues. Students having academic deficits were guided by 'Study skills' and 'Time-Table management'. One student belonging to ECE, MBA and

Mechanical was counselled for 'Emotional Disturbance' using CBT and Client centred therapy. They reported improvement. One parent of a 5th sem student approached to discuss the academic concerns of her son. Around seven students and one parent were counselled during the month of Apr-2023. One student from the first semester MBA had emotional disturbances due to the death of her friend. 'Positive Psychology' technique was used for counselling. A seminar on 'Orientation to Counselling' was conducted for first-semester MCA students.
