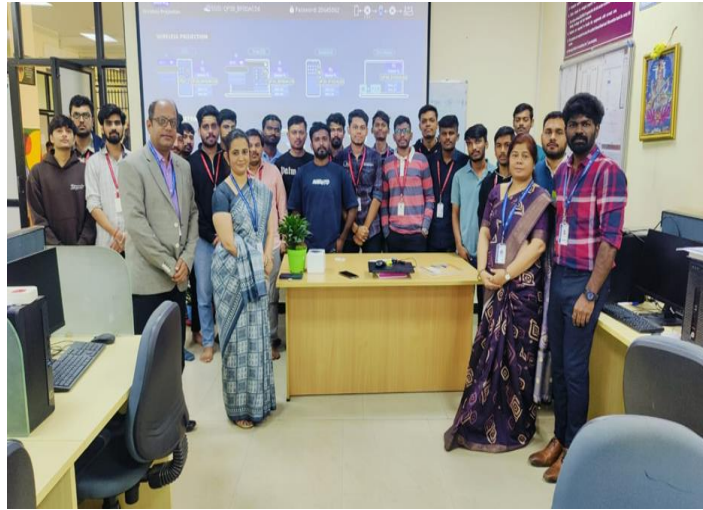
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### Students Workshop Conducted/ Organised

### BICEP Activities

#### ANVESHANA BOOTCAMP

The bootcamp is designed to build on the success of the Anveshana-Ideathon, which saw participation from around 800 students across 202 teams. Many students developed their ideas and prototypes during their IDT & SCR courses. This bootcamp aims to further refine the students' skills and capabilities. Spanning three weeks, the bootcamp will have mentors visiting the campus on Saturdays to assign tasks for the following week. The tentative session dates are January 11th, 18<sup>th</sup> January and the finale is planned in March.

The Anveshana Bootcamp, organized by BICEP –IIC (Institute Innovation Council) aimed to provide aspiring innovators with essential knowledge and practical tools to succeed in innovative projects towards market reach. The bootcamp featured Mr. Suhruth G Ujjni, a seasoned entrepreneur, who led the sessions. Mr. Suhruth has contributed significantly to the entrepreneurial landscape through initiatives like Startup



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Tumakuru, which supports local startups with idea validation, fundraising, and overcoming operational challenges. He also led the CIF Rajajinagar at K-tech Innovation Hub, helping secure over 210 crore INR in funding for 220 startups, and promoted Estonia's e-Residency program, assisting 350 entrepreneurs in establishing international businesses. His extensive experience has helped strengthen the entrepreneurial ecosystem through partnerships with government and educational institutions. Bootcamp is coordinated by Prof. Shama H M, Innovation coordinator.

Participants explored the use of frameworks like Business Model Canvas, financial planning, market segmentation, and unit economics in the first session. In the second session, Mr. Suhruth provided personalized mentorship, offering feedback on participants' ideas and guiding them in refining their value propositions and identifying target audiences. The afternoon session focused on evaluating and improving teams' Proof of Concept (PoC) prototypes, with Mr. Suhruth reviewing their feasibility and alignment with market needs. His guidance, along with the resources he shared, helped teams enhance their prototypes and become market ready. The bootcamp equipped participants with essential skills in prototyping, problem-solving, and iterative development, giving them the confidence to move forward in their entrepreneurial journeys.



### Code Red 25 hours National Level Hackathon

Code Red '25, a 25-hour national level hackathon, was held on 9th and 10th January 2025 at BMSIT&M, organized by BICEP - E-cell. The event provided a platform for participants to showcase their technical skills, ideation, and teamwork under time constraints. The inauguration ceremony had the chief guests, Shri K Joshil Raj, CEO of the Centre of Excellence in Design, IISc, and Shri Biinson B S, Talent Acquisition Head at Hughes Systique Corporation. The hackathon challenged participants with real-world problem statements, with 50 teams from across India advancing to the grand finale.



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The event was designed to foster innovation and collaboration, with expert evaluations from industry professionals like Nagendra Daivajna, Principal Consultant at Infosys, and Kushal Lokesh, Technical Director at NFThing. After 25 intense hours of development and refinement, the teams presented their prototypes, which were evaluated for their functional effectiveness and alignment with the theme. The total prize pool was INR 1,00,000, which was distributed among the winning teams and the event was supported by a budget of 3,62,884/- from BICEP – E-Cell.

The first phase of ₹50,000 per incubate will be released in February 2025, with the remaining amount disbursed based on subsequent requests and reviews by experts.

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### Counselling

Mrs. Chetana Srinivas, professional counsellor visits BMSIT campus on Tuesday and Friday from 1:30 pm to 4:30 pm, provides counselling for personal: academic, behavioural issues. Students having 'Academic deficits' were guided by effective study skills techniques and time table management. Deep breathing technique was introduced. One student of 1<sup>st</sup> semester CSE was counselled for the above. 2 students of 1<sup>st</sup> semester had emotional and thought disturbances 'Cognitive behavioural therapy and client centered therapy was used for counselling for the above. Both showed improvement. One student of 1<sup>st</sup> semester had emotional disturbance due to toxic roommate issue, she improved with 'communication strategies'.

Students of 5<sup>th</sup> semester had emotional disturbance which improved with 'gestalt therapy' and CBT. One student was counselled for shortage of attendance to adhere to college norms. One hostel staff was counselled for his personal issues with positive psychotherapy and client centered therapy, improvement was noted. To conclude 7 students and 1 hostel staff were counselled in the above period.




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
