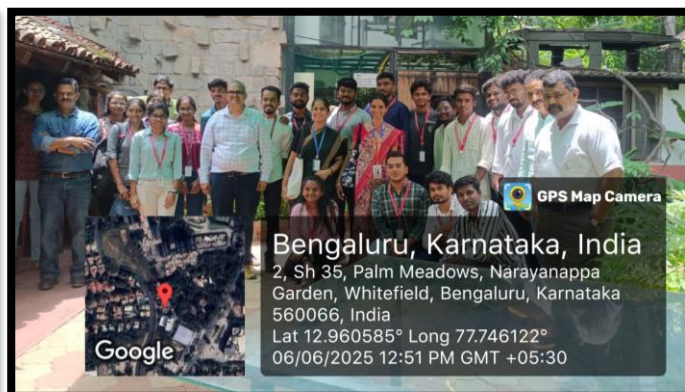

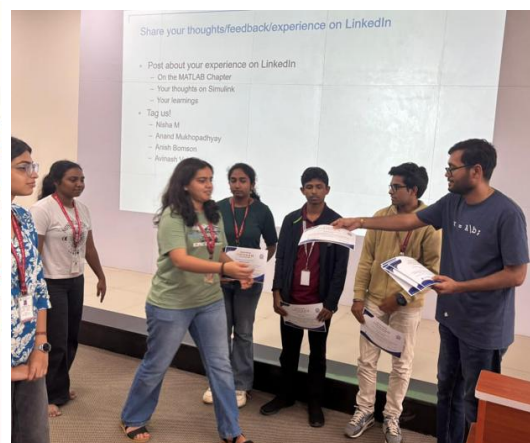


Students Workshop Conducted/ Organised

3. CATC – II / TSC -1 from 13.06.2025 to 22.06.2025

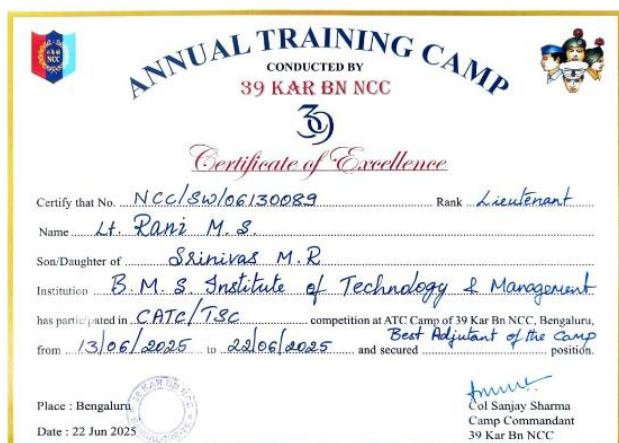

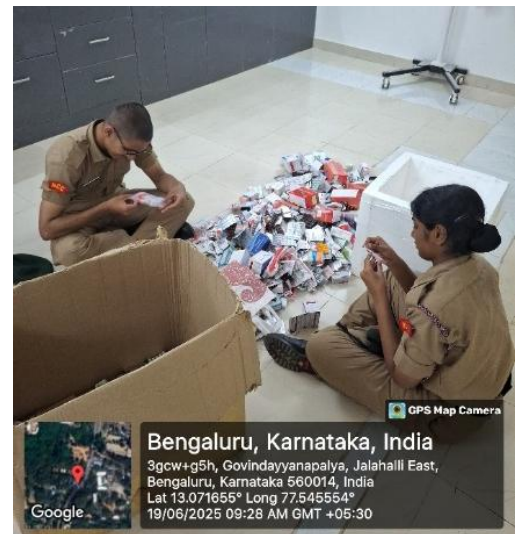
