Events Conducted







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2 PG students, NGO launch AI-based geo-tagging system to tag, identify trees across various campuses in city

While the Greater Bengaluru Authority's (GBA) ongoing tree census continues to crawl at a snail's pace, a team of students and volunteers from a city-based college and an NGO have come to the rescue.

Two postgraduate students from BMS Institute of Technology (BMSIT), in association with Green Circle, an NGO working on environmental causes, have devised an AI-based geo-tagging system to tag and identify trees on various campuses across the city.

Once tagged, the system will record key details, such as tree species, geographic coordinates, medicinal value of the tree, environmental benefits, and an estimate of the amount of carbon removed by a given tree from the atmosphere over its lifetime.




