The Principal welcomed all the members to the 3<sup>rd</sup> Academic Council meeting and asked the Member Secretary to proceed further with the presentation of the Agenda and notes.

### Description of the Item

The Minutes of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Academic Coincil were read and recorded as accepted as there were no deviations.

The member secretary presented the following:

- The action taken against the suggestions made by the members during the 2<sup>nd</sup> academic council meeting.
- The activities and achievements of faculty members and students since the 2<sup>nd</sup> Academic council meeting.
- Value added open courses, Research oriented internships, Digital writing pad for conductiong paperless examination, MOU with M/s CoCreate, Placement statistics, Analysis of examination results (2021-22) and the new PG courses being introduced.

Following are the details of the discussion and deliberation vis-à-vis the presentation made:

Dr Srinivas Padmanabhuni shared his observations/perspectives as follows:

- He suggested to present the list and registration details of open courses offered over the last 2 years to understand the scale and reach of the program.
- He suggested to conduct a pilot run before procuring the digital writing pads for examinations so that the gaps and technical glitches, if nay, can be identified and addressed.
- He stressed on the importance of faculty participation along with that of students in the
  institute's incubation activities. Principal added that M/s CoCreate(with whom BMSIT has
  an MOU) is willing to mentor the three teams which won the SIH 2022 and facilitate them
  to commercialize their ideas to products.
- He suggested to have Toast Master Club and Model United Nations (MUN) club so that the students can build on their current affairs knowledge and improvise on their communication and interpersonal skills. He appreciated the Internship offered for 3<sup>rd</sup> semester students and suggested to consider 3 weeks of MOOC/Coursera courses also as internship. Principal highlighted about the Kamsale and Kolata sessions conducted for students as part of Internship by the Janapada loka team with whom the institute has a MOU.
- He highlighted on strengthening the Alumni association in terms of Virtual lectures, recruitments, sponsored projects, internships, industry connections, industry interaction

- to greater heights. Prinicpal informed that the institute's Alumni network is quite young but strong, and assured to strengthen it further.
- He suggested that the faculty members can file patent/s out of their Ph.D work apart from publications. Principal expressed the flexibility provided for students to choose from the open courses offered by other departments. Added to it, he emphasized on the revised Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS) and Career Advancement Scheme (CAS) available for the faculty members where importance is not only given for publications but also for patents/sponsored projects/consultancy etc.

Dr Sudhamani briefied about the objectives of the MOU signed between the institute and M/s CoCreate, and their commitment towards supporting startups in the campus. She also highlighted the various activities carried out at Innovation centre for the benefit of student community.

#### Subjects for discussion and approval

The following subjects were discussed and approved:

- Dr Srinivas Padmanabhuni expressed his concern regarding the number of courses to be studied by students per semester. Principal explained the subject and mentioned that the scheme of teaching and examination for first year BE have been prescribed by the University and all the institutions under the ambit of the VTU are expected to follow the same. The academic council approved the same.
- The VTU has asked the autonomous institutions to follow the scheme of teaching and examination for I year BE as prescribed by the university, but has permitted to have a mximum of 20-30% deviation in the syllabus of th subjects.

#### Subject for Ratification

The following subjects were ratified:

- BOS meetings of all the departments are completed and have given approval for 2021-22 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> semester courses. With respect to the scheme and syllabi of the first year (AY 2022-23) couses, the Academic council ruled that the VTU's mandate shall be adhere to in suppression of the BOSs' prescrptions.
- Dr. Hanmuntharaju, CoE, brifed the design of grade sheet for autonomous batch of 2021 22. He also discussed about the internal and external examination pattern for 2021-22.
- After deliberations, it was finalized that the SEE pattern should comprise of 20 marks MCQs and 80 marks descriptive questions for 2021-22 autonomous batch, as has been the practice.
- The academic council asked the HOD of Al&ML to revisit the curriculum of 2<sup>nd</sup> year BE autonomous (Al&ML) and to include the subjects that are fundamental to any CSE/ISE/AIML student viz., Computer Organization (CO), Object Oriented Concepts (OOC), Data Communication (DC) and Software Engineering (SE) inline with the prescriptions of VTU.

Other members (HoDs) shared their suggestions and thanked all the external members for their valuable inputs.

The meeting concluded with thanks to the Chair.
