Sri. Aviram Sharma, Chairman, BOG, BMSIT&M, welcomed Dr B.S. Ragini Naryan, Donor Trustee, BMSET, Dr P. Dayananada Pai, Life Trustee, BMSET, Sri Ravi Venkatesam, Trustee, BMSET and all other BOG Members and Invitees for the 43rd Board of Governors Meeting.

Sri Aviram Sharma, Chairman, BOG, BMSIT&M, extended a warm welcome on behalf of the BMSIT&M Family to Dr N.C. Shivaprakash, VTU Nominee to the BOG, who attended the BOG meeting in-person for the first time at BMSIT&M. Dr Mohan Babu G N, Principal, extended a warm welcome to Mr Gautham V Kalathur, Chief Technology Officer, Permanent Invitee BOG, and the newly appointed Director of Administration, BMSET, Wg.Cdr. R.A. Raghavan. The Chairman then requested Dr. Mohan Babu G.N. to take up the agenda for the meeting.

The Principal informed the Hon'ble BOG members about the two accolades bestowed on BMSIT&M and requested the concerned faculty members to brief the Hon'ble BOG Members about the awards.

Mysore Horticultural Society, Lalbagh, had organized the Annual Gardening Competition as a part of the 75th Independence Day celebrations. Mr. T.N.Praveen Kumar, Asso. Prof. Mech Engg., who has been volunteering to manage BMSIT&M garden and its landscaping since 2004, shared with the Hon'ble BOG that BMSIT&M has been awarded the Best Ornamental Garden

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2022 Prize for the 7th consecutive time. In addition, Smt. B.R. Jayalakshmi Varma, Rolling Trophy for well maintained and environmentally friendly Garden Campus too, is awarded to BMSIT&M. The Hon'ble BOG Members appreciated the good work done by T.N. Praveen Kumar and his gardening staff.

Dr Rajesh Gopinath, Asso Prof., Dept. of Civil Engineering and Mr Venkatesh, Asst. Prof., Dept. of MCA, informed the Hon'ble BOG members that Environment Agency ECOR Foundation has conferred two awards on BMSIT&M: In the Organization category — OIKOS (Nature Club of BMSIT&M) and in the Individual Person category — to Dr Rajesh Gopinath. Principal mentioned about the two well-researched books authored by Dr. Rajesh Gopinath on flora and fauna of the BMSIT&M campus. Dr N. C. Shivaprakash, VTU Nominee, suggested having the Q.R. code for every plant/tree on the campus, which will enable recognition of the plant when the Q.R. Code is scanned. Further, he also suggested the inclusion of Medicinal Plants on the campus.

The BOG Members appreciated the efforts of OIKOS, Dr.Rajesh Gopinath, Faculty members and the Principal in keeping the Campus Green and Environment Friendly.

SECTION -1 FOR CONFIRMATION

43.1.1 Confirmation of the minutes of the 42nd BOG Meeting held on 11.03.2022

The minutes of the 42nd meeting of the Board of Governors held on 11.03.2022 was placed for confirmation, and the same was confirmed.

SECTION-2 ACTION TAKEN REPORT

43.2.1 Action taken report on the resolutions made in the BOG Meeting No. 42 held on 11.03.2022.

The action taken report on the points were noted and accepted.

Dr. P. Dayananda Pai, Life Trustee, BMSET, and Dr N.C. Shivaprakash preferred to employ more chartered bus services from BMTC rather than owning the buses to meet our transportation needs. The Principal, in his reply, informed that the institution is already making use of chartered services from BMTC, and 14 buses have been hired to address the transportation needs of the Institute. Mr Gautham V Kalathur expressed that the new buses, if procured could be used for Industrial Visits, Site Visits, and short excursions.

<u>SECTION-3</u> <u>SUBJECTS FOR INFORMATION</u>

43.3.1 I) Academic Matters

a) NBA Accreditation of MCA Program:

Dr P Dayananda Pai, Life Trustee, BMSET, Dr N. C. Shivaprakash and all other BOG Members appreciated the efforts of the Institute in securing NBA accreditation to the MCA program. Further, Dr N.C. Shivaprakash suggested that

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the BMSIT&M may consider increasing the intake of MCA, for which the Principal replied that it is proposed to do so from AY 2023-24.

b) NBA Accreditation for Five UG Programs:

The Hon'ble BOG Members noted and appreciated the efforts of the Principal, Faculty, and Staff members for the NBA Accreditation of 5 UG programs. Dr N.C. Shivaprakash suggested that the Institute may aim for Six years of accreditation the next time onwards.

c) AICTE and LIC Inspection wrt to MBA, M. Tech (Cy.Sec) and PIO Seats:

The Principal informed the Hon'ble BOG Members that all the proposals (Ref: Agenda and Notes, Academic point C) initiated by BMSIT&M have been approved by the AICTE after three rounds of rigorous online inspection. Further, the Principal informed that the proposed changes would be implemented for the Academic Year 2022-23.

Dr N.C. Shivaprakash suggested exploring the possibility of introducing BE program in CSBS, which M/s. TCS supports. However, Dr. Pai felt that the program might not be able to attract good enrollment and hence advised to take a cautious approach.

The efforts of the Principal, Faculty and Staff Members were noted and appreciated by the Hon'ble BOG Members.

d) PBL Exhibition/Hackathon/Competitions:

Principal explained the performance and special achievements of our students and faculty members in the various national-level and state-level competitions, such as:

- Product Development Proposal by Faculty:Dr N.C. Shivaprakash suggested the possibility of tying up with MSMED for funding and development. The Principal noted the suggestion.
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The BOG Members appreciated the effort of the participants and faculty members in conducting/participating in these competitions and winning prizes/recognition.

- e) VTU Education Conclave-2022: Principal informed about BMSIT&M's participation in the VTU Education conclave and the First prize won by our students in the project competition held there.
- f) Industrial Visits and Competency Enhancement Programs: Principal explained the following activities in detail.

The Hon'ble members of the BOG noted them with appreciations.

g) National Institutional Ranking Framework:

The Principal informed the Hon'ble BOG Members that BMSIT&M is ranked 199th in the NIRF Ranking compared to the previous ranking of 152. He informed the members of BOG that a committee is constituted under the guidance of Sri Aviram Sharma, Chairman, BOG, to analyze, introspect and act on the Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Threats (SWOT) of the Institute. The BOG noted that many factors determining the NIRF ranking are beyond the control of the Institute. However, it concurred with the Principal that the factors within the purview of the Institute's control may be focused closely.

Dr N.C. Shivaprakash informed the Members that out of about 3,000 colleges which participated in the NIRF Ranking 23 are IITs and 32 are NITs. There were a large number of central- and state-funded institutions too. He believed that BMSIT&M's 199th Rank while competing with these centrally- and-state-funded institutions is not a small achievement. However, he suggested that the Institute should concentrate on the factors within its control and work on its strengths. Sri Ravi Venkatesam, Trustee, BMSET, suggested studying the USP of Harvey Mudd, California, and how it can help BMSIT&M to achieve greater heights of excellence rather than giving excessive importance to NIRF Ranking.

The Principal confirmed to the Hon'ble BOG Members that all National/Major events/functions are being conducted jointly.

Dr N.C. Shivaprakash informed that 11th May is celebrated as World Technology Day, and the same may be celebrated at BMSIT&M. The suggestion was well received by the BOG Members, and the Principal also proposed to conduct Techtransform Day on the 11th of May every year.

43.3.2 Status of Placements:

The placement status was presented by Dr Manjunath T N, Placement Officer. The Hon'ble members of the BOG noted the status of placement of graduating students of BMSIT&M and appreciated the effort of the Placement officer, placement team, and all the HODs. Dr N.C. Shivaprakash appreciated the data format presented by the Placement Officer.

Dr Dayanada Pai enquired about the number of students opting for Higher Education, to which Principal responded as about 5 per cent. Dr Pai suggested encouraging students to appear for competitive exams such as IAS and KAS. Principal informed the BOG Members that the Institute collects information from first-year students about their aspirations which would be used to guide them with respect to their activities throughout the 4 years to help them move towards their aspirations. Dr N.C. Shivaprakash suggested a change in nomenclature from TPO (Training and Placement Officer) to Career Guidance Office. Principal said that currently, he has thought to bring all the three units namely, training and placement cell, higher education facilitation cell and entrepreneurship development cell under one head called Career Guidance Unit, and have one Dean as in-charge of the Unit.

Sri Aviram Sharma enquired about when students who do not have any offers currently can be placed. The Placement officer replied that such students are undergoing training till the end of September and will be placed once the training is completed.

The Draft Proposal of Performance-Based Incentive Plan to Encourage Departments was noted by the Hon'ble BOG Members and approved.

Dr S. K. Saidapur appreciated the progress made by BMSIT&M. He suggested that the Institute focus on international collaboration and encourage Creative, Critical and Innovative Thinking among Students and Faculty Members. Principal informed the Hon'ble BOG members that 'Design Thinking and Innovation' course has been introduced in the first-semester Curriculum, and seven faculty members are trained to teach it. PBL is another effort to promote

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creativity and innovativeness. He mentioned that several such initiatives are in vogue at BMSIT&M.

SECTION-6 ANY OTHER SUBJECT/S WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE CHAIR

Principal informed the Hon'ble BOG that Dr. Mohan Babu G.N. Principal and Dr.G.Thippeswamy, HOD, CSE were on the Zee Kannada News channel to educate students aspiring to pursue higher studies about choosing their study and career options.

Principal also informed the Hon'ble BOG that BMSIT&M uses 360 degree feedback, and the performance of HODs, Deans, Vice Principal and Principal are evaluated by their subordinates. He showed a table of ratings these functionaries received during 2021-22.

Principal also presented the University examination results with respect to the final year students.

The Members of the BOG complimented and placed on record the exemplary work carried out by the Principal and his team.
