45.3.1 I) Academic Matters

a) New UG and PG Programs Applied for AY 2023-24: Dr. Mohan Babu G N, Principal, BMSIT&M placed on record that using NBA Accreditation of 5 UG and 2 PG programs, BMSIT&M has sought approval from AICTE for an increase in intake and starting of new courses as follows:

The Proposal initiated by the Institute was noted and approved by the Hon'ble BOG Members. Further, Dr Mohan Babu G N informed the Hon'ble BOG Members that VTU has issued NOC for the Proposal mentioned above. AICTE's extension of Approval (EOA), and approval for proposed changes is awaited.

b) Applications by the Dept of Civil Engg Seeking NBA and NABL Accreditations and Recognition as a Research Centre:

Application for NBA Accreditation: Dr Mohan Babu G N, Principal, BMSIT&M, informed the Hon'ble BOG Members that the Dept. of Civil Engineering has applied for NBA Accreditation and in the process, has submitted e-SAR. As a result, the NBA Expert Committee is expected to visit BMSIT&M for inspection in the month of June/July 2023. Further, the Principal informed the BOG Members that the Department is fully prepared for the NBA Inspection.

Application for NABL Accreditation: Dr Mohan Babu G N, Principal, BMSIT&M, informed the Hon'ble BOG Members that the Dept. of Civil Engineering has applied for National Accreditation Board for Testing & Calibration Laboratories. The Expert Team is expected to visit BMSIT&M in the month of May or June. The NABL Accreditation will help BMSIT&M in consultation work.



Dr. Mohan Babu G N informed the Hon'ble BOG Members that VTU has recognized the Dept. of Civil Engineering as a research centre in 2023; it was duly noted and appreciated by the Hon'ble BOG Members.

- c) Extension of NAAC "A" Grade till 2026: Dr Mohan Babu G N, Principal, BMSIT&M, informed the Hon'ble BOG Members that the existing NAAC Accreditation of "A" Grade has ended in September 2022 and BMSIT&M had approached NAAC for initiating Re-accreditation process. However, the authorities at NAAC informed us to seek/apply for Reaccreditation only after passing out of 2 batches of students under Autonomous System. Hence, NAAC has extended the Accreditation with "A" Grade till 2026.
- d) Faculty Members awarded with Ph.D Degrees: Dr Mohan Babu G N, Principal, placed on record that 10 Faculty Members of BMSIT&M have been awarded with Ph.D Degree and 08 Faculty Members from other institutions registered as Research Scholars were also awarded with Ph.D Degrees. With this, the number of Faculty Members with Ph.D has increased to 70%. The Principal also recorded that currently 86 Faculty Members from other institutions are pursuing Ph.D at the 11 Research Centres at BMSIT&M, which reflects on Research Centres credibility.

Dr. Manjunath T N, Dean Career Guidance, presented the placement status. The Hon'ble Members of BOG noted the status of placement of graduating students and appreciated the effort of the Dean Career Guidance, placement team, and HOD's of the Departments.

Sri Gautham V Kalathur, enquired about situations wherein a student having two offers in hand opts for the one with better pay, and what happens to the offer that is dropped? In reply Dr. Manjunath T N explained that job offers are categorized into four categories, and the students are free to choose the best offer. The categories are:

Categories	Pay Package
Silver Category	Up to 6 Lakhs per Annum
Gold Category	6 to 8 Lakhs per Annum
Platinum Category	8 to 11 Lakhs per Annum
Dream Offer	More than 11 Lakhs per Annum

Dr. Manjunath T N, further explained that the placement team makes all efforts to fill the dropped offers with the next meritorious student/s in line. The Institute also has in place a policy for students to seek more than one offer i.e., when the salary offered by the second company is at least 1.5 times the salary offered by the first company.

He also placed on record that: 1,140 internships have been rolled out and out of which 633 are paid internships, the minimum stipend being ₹ 12,000 and the maximum being ₹ 80,000.

He made a detailed presentation about the number of students enrolled for placements, the total number of students placed, students wanting to continue their higher education and students aspiring for Civil Services.

The efforts of the Placement team was noted and well appreciated by the Hon'ble BOG Members.

Hence, it was felt to have a policy recognizing the services of long-serving Assistant Professors at BMSIT&M. The Policy permitted the promotion of Assistant Professors from S1/S2/ or S3 to Associate Professor based on the following criteria:

- i. He/She shall have completed an age of 52 years.
- ii. He/Shee shall have 15 years of service at BMSIT&M.
- iii. He/She Shall have 2 years of Post-Ph.D experience at BMSIT&M.
- iv. He/She shall have no antecedents of indiscipline leading to punishment.
- v. He/She shall qualify in the Interview.

The Teachers promoted under Time-bound promotion were noted and approved by the Hon'ble BOG Members.
